ORDER

WHEREAS the Committee for the Management of Joint AGMUT Cadre of Indian Forest Service was convened on 04.09.2009 to consider the case for promotion of officers in the Joint AGMUT Cadre of IFS to various grades in the Cadre against the vacancies arose consequent on Review of the Cadre Strength notified by the Department of Personnel & Training, Government of India; vide Notification No.16016/06/2008-AIS-II(A) dated 24.03.2009 [G.S.R. 193(E)]; as also against the resultant vacancies arose in the cadre on account of superannuation of the incumbents. The recommendations of the Committee as contained in its Minutes of the Meeting held on 04.09.2009 was considered and with the approval of the competent authority; office orders dated 23.09.2009 and 09.12.2009; effecting promotions in various grades in the Joint AGMUT Cadre of IFS, were issued.

2. AND WHEREAS a disciplinary proceedings case was in progress against Shri Prabhat Tyagi, IFS(AGMUT:1995); on account of which vigilance clearance was withheld in his case and this fact was placed before the Committee. The Committee in its meeting held on 04.09.2009 considered the case for grant of Selection Grade as well as for promotion to the Grade of Conservator of Forests in respect of Shri Prabhat Tyagi. The findings of the Committee regarding suitability for promotion to the Selection Grade and that for promotion to the grade of Conservator of Forest in respect of Shri Prabhat Tyagi was, however, kept in sealed cover by the Committee, in the light of Shri Prabhat Tyagi not being clear from vigilance angle on account of the then ongoing disciplinary proceedings.

3. AND WHEREAS the disciplinary proceedings initiated against Shri Prabhat Tyagi was finally disposed off and vide order No.12011/22/2002-AVU(Vol.II) dated 11.05.2010 wherein Shri Prabhat Tyagi was exonerated of all the charges levelled against him.

4. AND WHEREAS Shri Prabhat Tyagi having been exonerated of all the charges levelled against him vide order dated 11.05.2010, the sealed covers containing the findings of the Committee for the Management of Joint AGMUT Cadre of Indian Forest Service held on 04.09.2009 were opened on 07.07.2010 and it has been found that the Committee for the Management of Joint AGMUT Cadre of Indian Forest Service have found Shri Prabhat Tyagi "fit for promotion" to the grade of Conservator of Forests as well as for grant of Selection Grade.

5. NOW THEREFORE, after considering the findings of the Committee for the Management of Joint AGMUT Cadre of Indian Forest Service; as arrived at in its meeting held on 04.09.2009 and kept in the sealed covers, the competent authority has decided to grant Selection Grade to Shri Prabhat Tyagi w.e.f. 01.01.2009 and promote him to the grade of Conservator of Forests w.e.f. 09.12.2009 i.e. the date from which his junior in the cadre was promoted to the grade of Conservator of Forests. Accordingly Shri Prabhat Tyagi, IFS(AGMUT:1995) who is in the Junior Administrative Grade (Pay Band 3 :Rs.15,600-39,100/- + Grade Pay of Rs.7,600/-) is promoted to the Selection Grade (Pay Band 4 : Rs.37,400 – 67,000/- + Grade Pay of Rs.8,700/-) with effect from 01.01.2009, and Shri Prabhat Tyagi is further promoted to the grade of Conservator of Forests (Pay Band 4 : Rs. 37,400 – 67,000/- + Grade Pay of Rs.8,900/-) with effect from 09.12.2009 i.e. the date from which his junior Shri R.S.Sinha, IFS(AGMUT:1995) was promoted to the grade of CF vide Office Order No.46011/3/2009-IFS-I(AGMUT)/(71) dated 09.12.2009.
