Sub: Nominations of Indian Forest Service officers for appointment to Forestry Posts at the level of ADGF/APCCF/CCF/CF/DCF on tenure deputation basis covered under the Central Staffing Scheme of the Ministry of Environment and Forests - regarding.

Sir/Madam,

The Ministry of Environment and Forests invites nominations of eligible and willing IFS officers for appointment against the Forestry Posts at the level of ADGF/APCCF/CCF/CF/DCF to prepare "OFFER LIST" for respective level posts, under the Central Staffing Scheme of the Ministry Environment and Forests .

2. The eligibility criteria for different level posts will be applicable as laid down in the revised CSS-MoEF Scheme dated 06.05.2011 available on IFS website at www.ifs.nic.in. However, as far as the eligibility of batches vis-a-vis the minimum years of service is concerned, the IFS officers of following batches will be eligible to apply at respective level posts. In addition to this batch wise eligibility, one year of overlap at every level will also be allowed, if the officer is willing for the post at the lower level.

3. The minimum years of service (as per the respective post) will be with reference to 01.01.2012 and the minimum year of service left before superannuation will be counted from 01.01.2012.

4. The State Governments are requested to forward the nominations of the willing officers, clear from vigilance angle and whose services can be spared. Officers who have completed one spell of central deputation may be considered for a further spell of central deputation only after they have completed the stipulated cooling off period on 31.03.2012. It is clarified that the cooling off period is reckoned from the date the officer reports back to his/her cadre on completion of earlier deputation tenure.

5. The officer selected for appointment, if fails to take up the central deputation assignment after the appointment is approved, he will attract a '**5 years debarment**' from central deputation including foreign deputation /foreign training/ foreign assignment etc.

6. The application complete in all respects as per Annexure-I and Annexure-II alongwith copy of updated Executive Records Sheet (available on the website www.ifs.nic.in), vigilance clearance and concurrence of the state government should be sent to the Director (IFS), Room No.503, Paryavaran Bhawan, CGO Complex, Lodi Road, New Delhi- 110003 latest by 31st March, 2012. Application received without the consent of the State / UT government/ after the date of receipt of applications will not be entertained. The applicant may forward his/her application through online on IFS website www.ifs.nic.in. However, the application so forwarded will be eligible for consideration only after it has been received with the consent of the concerned State Government /UTs by 31st March 2012.
