Subject: Nominations of Indian Forest Service Officers for appointment on tenure deputation basis to the posts of DIGF/AIGF in NTCA under the Central Staffing Scheme of the Ministry of Environment and Forests-reg.

Sir/Madam,

The Ministry of Environment and Forests invites nominations of suitable IFS officers for appointment against following vacancies at various levels under the Central Staffing Scheme of this Ministry. The eligible batches falling within zone of consideration are for CF/DIGF level is 1988-93 and for DCF/AIGF level posts is 1994-2003:-

2. The State Governments are requested to forward the nominations of the willing officers who are clear from vigilance angle and whose services can be spared. Officers who have completed one spell of central deputation may be considered for a further spell of central deputation only after they have completed the stipulated cooling off period or will be completing cooling off period is reckoned from the date the officer reports back to his/her cadre on completion of earlier deputation tenure.



3. In terms of Indian Forest Service (Cadre) Rules, 1966 and other Service conditions governing the Indian Forest Service officers, consent of IFS officers is neither necessary for nomination/ appointment against Central Deputation Reserve posts, nor for their placement anywhere in the country, many a times, nomination of unwilling personnel would be a bottle neck to the efficient management of the service. It is also noticed in this context that some of the State Cadre authorities do not consult/inform the officers concerned while recommending their names for empanelment. Many a time, this results in the empanelled officers expressing unwillingness to take up the central deputation appointments inspite of the fact that the deputation orders have been issued after a long selection process . If an officer selected for appointment fails to take up the central deputation assignment after the appointment is approved, he will attract a '5 year debarment' from central deputation including foreign deputation/foreign training/ foreign assignment etc.

4. The application complete in all respects as per Annexure-I and Annexure-II alongwith copy of updated Executive Records Sheet (available on the website www.ifs.nic.in), vigilance clearance and concurrence of the state government should be sent to the Director (IFS-I), Room No. 503, Paryavaran Bhawan, CGO Complex, Lodhi Road, NewDelhi-110003 latest by **10th December, 2010**.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to say that in terms of para 13(i) & (v) (A) of the revised central staffing scheme of this Ministry circulated vide O.M no. A.12011/01/2003-IFS-I dated 9th May, 2007, this Ministry has submitted three proposals belonging to 1978, 1979 & 1980 batches of IFS officers to the Appointment Committee of the Cabinet (ACC) for empanelment at the level of posts carrying pay scale of HAG (i.e Rs. 67000-79000). The names of officers sent to ACC for empanelment to the posts of HAG at the Centre under Central Staffing Scheme of Ministry of Environment & Forests are being enclosed as annexure I

2. In the meantime, the competent authority has decided to prepare a pool of willing IFS officers to work at the centre at HAG level post amongst 1978, 1979 & 1980 batches. Accordingly the State Government is requested to forward the nominations of the willing officers who are clear from vigilance angle and whose services can be spared at the time of his/her selection for the aforesaid post. Officers who have completed one spell of central deputation may be considered for a further spell of central deputation only after they have completed the stipulated cooling off period. It is clarified that the cooling off period is reckoned from the date the officer reports back to his/her cadre on completion of earlier deputation tenure. The deputation will be in accordance with the DoPT deputation guidelines for AIS officers. The nomination should accompany following documents/ certificates:-

- (b) Executive records of the officer indicating the posts held so far throughout the career in chronological order.
