

**Minutes of the Meeting of Special Selection Committee held on 02.08.2011 to consider cases of IGF & equivalent level posts covered under CSS-MoEF**

The Meeting of the Special Selection Committee for recommending names/ panel to the posts at the level of Inspector General of Forests and equivalent level was held on 02.08. 2011 in the chambers of Secretary , Ministry of Environment & Forests in Paryavaran Bhawan, CGO Complex, Lodi Road, New Delhi.

The Committee while considering the names, from the offer list of IGF level, for appointment against the vacant posts at the level of IGF and equivalent level in the Government of India took into account the need of the Ministry, the officers general and specific professional experience, the academic qualifications, the experience relevant to the work in the Ministry due regard to seniority and suitability for specific post/(s), their Annual Confidential Reports (ACRs) / Personal Appraisal Reports (PARs), and other relevant record for ascertaining their suitability for induction into Central Deputation posts available.

The Committee also considered cases of in-situ promotion to those eligible IFS Officers, who are presently working on up-graded posts at the level of APCCF and CCF under CSS of MoEF and also eligible, in accordance with CSS-MoEF deputation guidelines and MoEF circular for filling up deputation posts.
