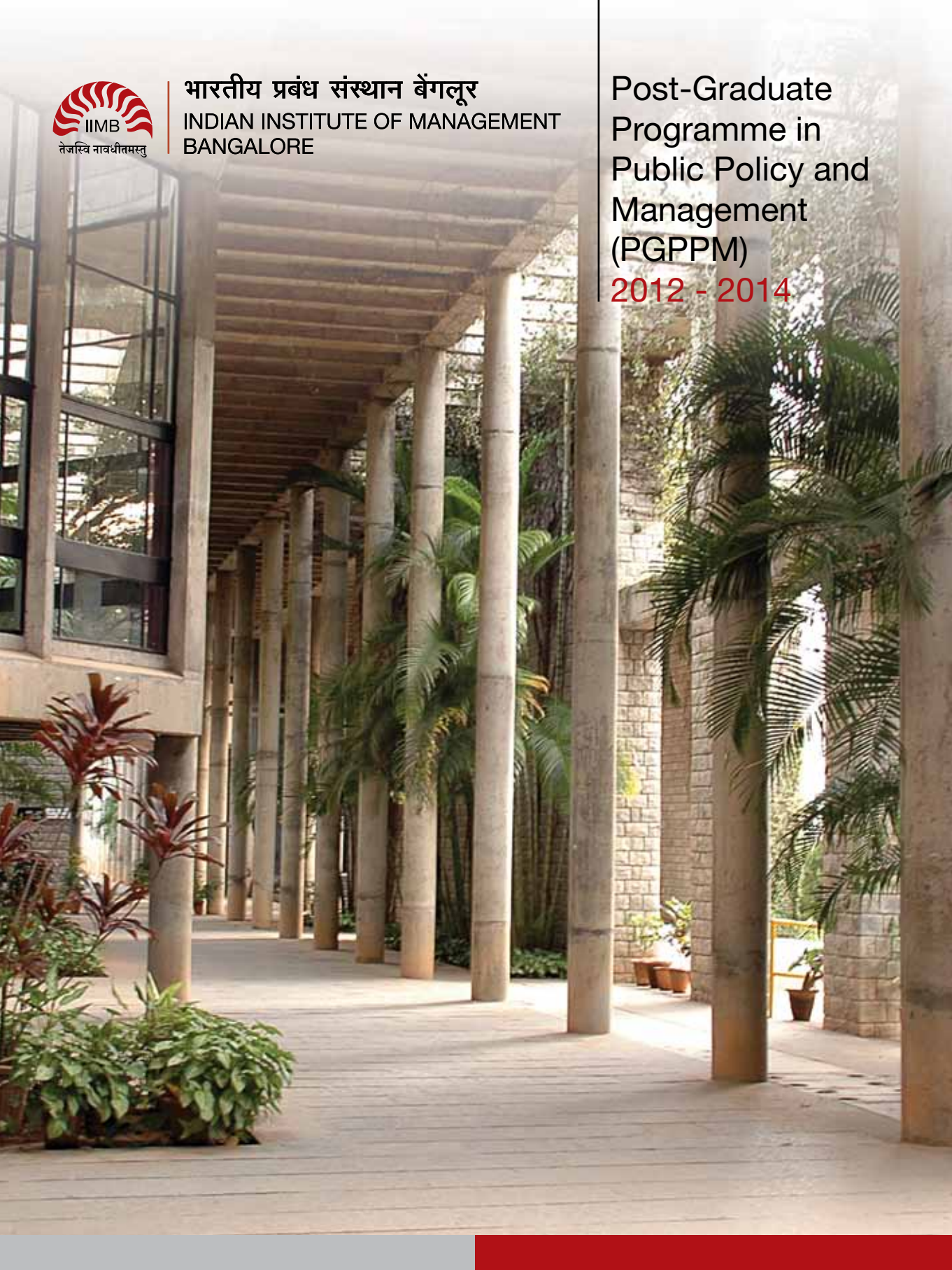

About the Institute

The Indian Institute of Management Bangalore (IIMB) is a premier management institute in India. IIMB has carved a niche for itself among the top management schools in the world – an Institute with international reputation for its post-graduate and doctoral level programmes. It has a strong reputation in management research, consulting and executive education.

IIMB's distinctive feature is its strong focus on leadership skills that are necessary to succeed in today's dynamic business environment. The Institute's faculty members are globally respected academicians who are experts in various disciplines with experience in diverse domains and sectors.

About the Programme

The Post Graduate Programme in Public Policy and Management (PGPPM) was flagged off from the Centre for Public Policy (CPP), a joint initiative of IIMB, UNDP and DoPT, Govt. Its main aim is to develop an alternate think tank through excellence in research and scholarship, and education and training.

The PGPPM at the Indian Institute of Management Bangalore (IIMB) aims at strengthening the public policy and managerial skills of future leaders and senior managers from the civil services; and of the professionals from social, infrastructure and private sectors.

Programme Objectives

The PGPPM helps professionals engaged in public policy and management to tackle new challenges in the context of liberalization, globalization and rapid technology change, and continuing burden of poverty, social exclusion and crisis.

The Programme focuses on:

- Deepening conceptual, technical and analytical skills for public policy making
- Developing leadership skills
- Understanding forces that shape the domestic and international environment for public policy
- Specializing in a chosen public policy field
- Learning from comparative study of other countries



Academic Design

PGPPM is designed to focus on:

- Inter-disciplinary learning
- Shared learning, cross learning, and learning from experience
- Self-study and in-depth learning in the area of specialization
- Foreign study component

A key component of the programme is the dissertation which provides for undertaking a comprehensive study of a chosen public policy issue.

The Programme Structure

The programme is of two years duration. The participants spend the first year undertaking coursework and continue their dissertations in the second year.

The programme structure is as follows:

- Term 1 and 2 (8 weeks each): Public policy and general management courses
- Term 3 (7 weeks): Open and overseas candidates take electives offered by the other long duration programmes at IIMB and undertake a project involving a government department as a case study, under guidance of an IIMB faculty member. Government sponsored candidates undertake a core international module on public policy in international comparative perspective and write a policy paper at Maxwell School of Citizenship and Public Affairs, Syracuse University, USA.
- Term 4 and 5 (6 and 7 weeks): Electives in the areas of specialization and courses from general streams
- Term 6: Dissertation which is continued in the second year

Participant Group

The programme was initially started for officers of All India Services and Central Services in their mid-career and wanting to reinvent themselves. Subsequently, the programme was extended to open candidates from private and non-government sectors such as infrastructure, telecommunication, banking, healthcare, and regulatory agencies, etc. Considerable synergies exist among private and public sectors and we expect this to enable cross learning.

Starting last year, PGPPM has added another dimension to the learning experience by opening admission to overseas participants. Efforts are to make it a global programme.

International Exposure

During term 3, the participants admitted through the Government, spend seven weeks in a top international public policy institution, the Maxwell School of Citizenship and Public Affairs, Syracuse University, USA. The focus is on providing an international perspective on public policy issues and the stint includes a visit to Washington. Participants work with Maxwell faculty to develop an in-depth policy paper on a subject of their choice.

Open and overseas candidates are expected to take electives from long duration programmes such as EPGP and PGSEM at IIMB during the same term. They will also be doing a project involving a department of the government as a case study, under the guidance of an IIMB faculty. They also have the option of undertaking the International Program at Maxwell School by paying the required additional fee.

Selection Process

Selection of open and overseas candidates is based on a two stage process. Candidates will be first selected to be called for interview based on the following criteria:

- Academic Background
- CAT 2011 / GMAT / GRE scores
- Work Experience
- Achievements (Academic and Career related)



At the second stage, selected candidates will be interviewed in Delhi or Bangalore. They will be required to do a case analysis on the day of the interview. For open candidates residing abroad and overseas candidates, the interviews can be arranged through video conference/Skype mode at a mutually convenient date and time.

The admission process is highly personalized as the Committee seeks to learn about each candidate's goals, interest in getting engaged with the public system, present exposure to Indian and global scenarios, and potential for success in public management.

The Government sponsored candidates have to apply through the Department of Personnel and Training (DoPT), Government of India (GoI), as per normal procedure. They will be called for interviews in Delhi or Bangalore and will be required to do a case analysis at the time of interview.

Course Fee

The Programme fees for open and overseas candidates is ₹ 9,75,000 inclusive of tuition fee, books/course material, library services, computer facilities, shared accommodation, alumni fee. For open and overseas candidates opting for the international module, the programme fees and related expenses of the international component will be known prior to the visit to Syracuse. Programme fees for Government sponsored candidates will be paid by the concerned departments and the DoPT, GoI, as per rules.

Facilities on Campus

Indian Institute of Management Bangalore is a 100 acre oasis. It has modern classroom complexes, a well developed library and a state of the art computer centre. The campus provides an ideal environment for learning, writing and undertaking research. Participants will have an opportunity to interact with students from other programmes through common classes, seminars, round table discussions and conferences. The campus has facilities for various outdoor and indoor sports.

Accommodation

Open and overseas candidates will be provided accommodation in an apartment complex about 3.5 km from the campus on a sharing basis. The commuting time is about 10 minutes from the campus. Frequent shuttle service between the apartment complex and the campus is provided. The apartment complex has facilities such as a health club, swimming pool, club house, etc. All apartments are furnished with basic requirements. Open and overseas candidates desirous of having an independent two bedroom family apartment would be required to pay an additional fee of ₹ 1,25,000.

Government sponsored candidates will be provided accommodation in housing units on campus on a sharing basis. These housing units are also furnished with basic needs.

Eligibility Criteria

Open and Overseas Candidates

- Age below 40 years as on June 1, 2012
- Graduate in any discipline
- Should have valid scores from GMAT/GRE obtained between April 1, 2010 to January 1, 2012 or CAT 2011
- Ideal candidates should have full time work experience of five to seven years.

Government Sponsored Candidates

All India Services and Central Services Group A Officers are eligible subject to the following conditions:

- Age below 50 years (53 in case of SC/ST) as on June 1, 2012
- Graduate in any discipline
- Minimum of seven years experience
- Should not have undertaken any training either in India or abroad within the last 5 years

Placement

Open participants can opt for placement on submitting a defensible draft in the second year. Career counseling and placement assistance will be provided to open participants.

How to Apply

Open and Overseas Candidates

Open and overseas candidates should fill in the online application form available at www.iimb.ernet.in and submit online along with the application fee.

Government Sponsored Candidates

Officers from All India and Central Services are required to forward the duly filled-in application available at the IIMB website www.iimb.ernet.in, through the concerned departments to the Under Secretary, Department of Personnel & Training (DoPT), Government of India. An advance copy of the application should be sent to The Administrative Officer (PGPPM), Indian Institute of Management Bangalore. Please visit IIMB website and DoPT website for further details.

Application Fee

For open and overseas candidates applying with GMAT/GRE scores, the application fee is ₹1500/- (Rupees one thousand five hundred only) and for those open candidates who take the CAT 2011, the application fee is ₹500/- (Rupees five hundred only).

For the Government sponsored participants, there is no application fee.

The application fee should be paid online through the payment gateway while submitting the application form.
