- 1 The recommendations of the 'Task Force' on the proposed merger of 'Central Sector Forestry Training Schemes' have been forwarded to the Working Group on "Education, Training, Research and Capacity Building in the Environment and Forests Sector", constituted by the Planning Commission for the Eleventh Five Year Plan for its consideration and approval before incorporation in the FYP proposals .
