DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Under the overall guidance of Director, Forest Resources Division, and the general supervision of Chief, Forest Resources Development Service, will lead development and implementation of sustainable forest management including policy and monitoring processes at local, national and international levels. Specifically to:

- * ensure the further development of concepts and methods for field implementation of sustainable forest management, with emphasis on tropical regions, including documentation and knowledge dissemination, taking into consideration the multiple social, economic and environmental functions of forests and the contribution of forest management to broader development goals, in particular the Millennium Development Goals;
- * support the integration of results from monitoring and assessment processes at international, national and local levels into the forest management planning processes for evaluation of options and support to decision-making;
- * support inclusion of the sustainable forest management concept in international forest-related arrangements, including to provide policy and technical inputs and updates as well as obtaining feedback from decisions and recommendations for further improvements of the concept and its implementation;
- * coordinate and supervise FAO's support to regional and national processes on criteria and indicators for sustainable forest management;
- * coordinate case studies of sustainable forest management implementation in all regions, including to collaborate with national and international organizations in this field;
- * be responsible for the preparation of international meetings, related documentation and participate/conduct as necessary;
- * prepare publications on methods and implementation of sustainable forest management, including inputs to key FAO publications, such as the biennial State of the World's Forests;
- * monitor and evaluate computer applications and information systems for forest management planning;
- * supervise the electronic publishing of forest management information for all countries on the FAO website;
- * backstop field projects related to forest management;
- * provide guidance and day-to-day supervision of staff ensuring overall coordination of activities, including related personnel and administrative actions;
- * serve as focal point for collaboration with other divisions and departments, and maintain international networks
